NOTIFICATION:

This letter is to inform you that pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/14-3(q), Crawley of Vermilion County Metropolitan Enforcement Group, requests approval to intercept, listen, and record conversations between CS20-022 and the above named target, and others yet unknown, for a reasonable period of time, but in no event longer than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours. This investigation involves Bartley selling narcotics, a qualified offense as defined by 720 ILCS 5/14-3(q)(7).

TIME PERIOD FOR USE OF EAVESDROPPING DEVICE:

(12:30 p.m. on September 18th 2020 through 12:30 p.m. on September 19th 2020)

Reasonable cause exists to believe that inculpatory conversations concerning a qualified offense will occur between CS20-022 and the above named target and the consenting party/parties, within the above stated time period. I, Agent Crawley, have learned through my investigation the following:

Summary

On 09-18-20 I (Agent Crawley #9935) with the Vermilion County Metropolitan Enforcement Group made contact with "CS #20-022" about assisting VMEG with conducting another controlled purchase of Meth from a subject that this "CS" had identified as George E. Bartley (M/W 07-23-68). On 09-17-20 Bartley had agreed to sell this "CS" a couple of ounces of Meth in Peoria Co. Illinois on 09-18-20.

I would like to note that on 08-06-20 at around 2336 hrs. this "CS" had purchased 28.9 gram of a substance that field tested positive for Meth and 28.7 gram of a substance that field tested positive for Cannabis from Bartley at 2700 West Malone St. in Peoria, Illinois during a controlled buy.

This "CS" is a reliable "CS" that has assisted VMEG with past controlled purchases were class X amounts of Meth had been purchased.
