## Executive Summary

This report is compiled to satisfy the requirements of Chapter 730 ILCS 5/5-8-1.1. The current Impact Incarceration Program (IIP) facilities are located at Dixon Springs in the Shawnee National Forest in southeastern Illinois and at the DuQuoin State Fairgrounds in southern Illinois.

In FY2021, Illinois Department of Corrections accepted the recommendations of judges from 9 counties that referred 9 inmates to participate in IIP. Of those admitted into IIP, 88.9% (8) successfully completed the program and were released to Mandatory Supervised Release (MSR) in the community. The 3-Year recidivism rate for FY2018 IIP graduates was XX.X% compared with the overall departmental recidivism rate of XX.X% for the same year.<sup>1</sup>

Please note, due to COVID restrictions based on CDC recommendations, that began in March 2020, all Impact Incarceration Programs were suspended.

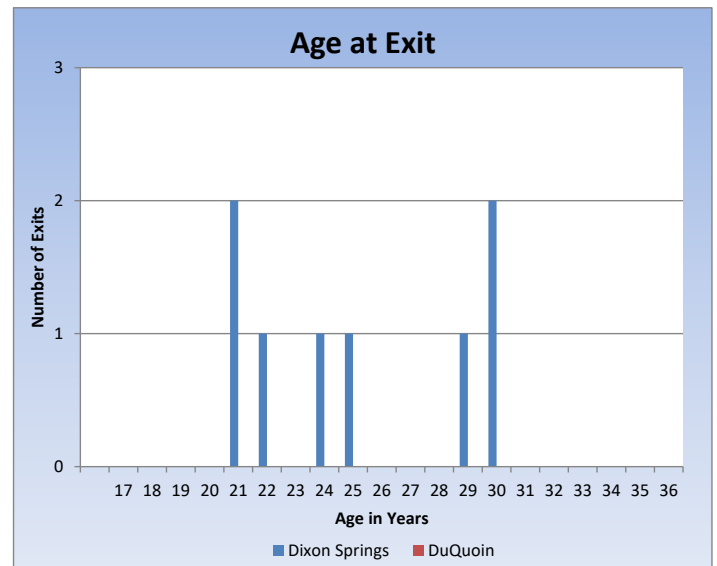
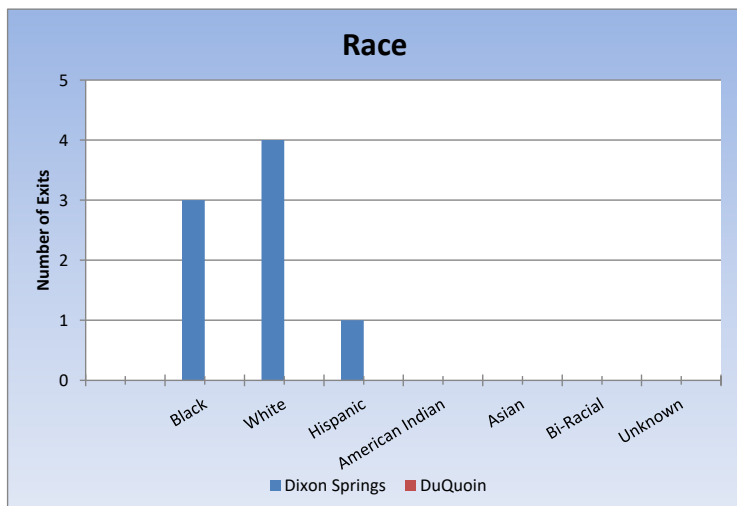
