2022 Report Comments

Changes from 2021 report in orange.

- 2 The inclusion of new hunting programs on existing acres at William Powers led to the addition of hunting opportunities on 438 acres of the site.
- 4 The addition of a Youth Turkey Season led to an increase in huntable acres on Edward Madigan to a total of 365 acres.
- 4 Although waterfowl hunting has been allowed on Meredosia Lake for several years, the acres were not included in previous reports, potentially due to the ownership of the property being USFWS. Because IDNR manages a hunting program that allows public access to the site, it is being included on this and future reports.
- 5 A previous miscalculation of hunting access acres on Cache River - Glass Hill was corrected, increasing total huntable acres to 232.
- 5 The addition of acreage through the acquisition of the Cox Unit, increased huntable acreage at Chauncey Marsh to 775 acres.

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
