In 2018 the Williamson County Sheriff's Office received a Camera Grant for the purchase of 10 in-car video systems. This brought our total number of cameras to 18. All of the Camera systems were installed by the deadline and were placed into immediate use.

The camera recordings are downloaded into a computer workstation by the Deputy and stored. Supervisors can review each video by date and time. Copies of arrests and or citations when requested by the States Attorney's Office are copied and transferred to a DVD for evidentiary purposes.

I would like to thank the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board, The Governor of Illinois and the Illinois General Assembly for making these funds available to server our community and protect our officers.
