## MINUTES

April 17, 2018

### MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Co-Chair Wheeler called the meeting to order and announced that the policy of the Committee is to allow only representatives of State agencies to testify orally on any rule under consideration at Committee meetings. Other persons are encouraged to submit their comments to the JCAR office in writing.

### APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH 13, 2018 MEETING

Representative Demmer moved, seconded by Senator Althoff, that the minutes of the March 13, 2018 meeting be approved. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

### REVIEW OF AGENCY RULEMAKINGS

*Department of Insurance – Domestic Insurers Service of Process Requirements (50 Ill. Adm. Code 206; 41 Ill. Reg. 12761)*

Representative Thapedi moved, seconded by Senator Weaver, that JCAR and the Department of Insurance extend the Second Notice period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

### CONSIDERATION OF OTHER RULEMAKINGS

*State Board of Education – Public Schools Evaluation, Recognition, and Supervision (23 Ill. Adm. Code 1; 41 Ill. Reg. 15542)*

Lindsay Bentivegna, Rules Coordinator, and Jeff Aranowski, Executive Director for Safe & Healthy Climate, represented SBE.

Co-Chair Wheeler asked if SBE would agree to an Extension. SBE agreed. Co-Chair Harmon moved, seconded by Representative Breen, that JCAR and the State Board of Education extend the Second Notice period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

*Environmental Protection Agency – Procedures for Informational and Quasi-Legislative Public Hearings (35 Ill. Adm. Code 164; 41 Ill. Reg. 14851); Procedures for Permit and Closure Plan Hearings (35 Ill. Adm. Code 166; 41 Ill. Reg. 14856); Public Participation in the Air Pollution Control Permit Program (35 Ill. Adm. Code 252; 41 Ill. Reg. 14862)*

Senator Althoff moved, seconded by Representative Demmer, that JCAR and EPA extend the Second Notice period for these rulemakings for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

*Department of Human Services – Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Treatment and Intervention Licenses (77 Ill. Adm. Code 2060; 41 Ill. Reg. 14878)*

Rick Nance, Deputy Director, and Tracie Drew, Rules Coordinator, represented DHS.

Representative Harris: JCAR wants to clarify the intent of this rule and ensure that it meshes with the language of the budget implementation bill (SB 42). He asked if DHS would agree to an Extension. Ms Drew agreed. Representative Harris moved, seconded by Senator Weaver, that JCAR and DHS extend the Second Notice period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

#### **CERTIFICATION OF NO OBJECTION**

Senator Althoff moved, seconded by Representative Lang, that the Committee inform the agencies to whose rulemakings the Committee did not vote an Objection or Extension, or did not remove from the No Objection List, that the Committee considered their respective rulemakings at the monthly meeting and, based upon the agreements for modification of the rulemakings made by the agencies, no Objections will be issued. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).
