April 9, 2019

### APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH 12, 2019 MEETING

Rep. Thapedi moved, seconded by Sen. Schimpf, that the minutes of the March 12, 2019 meeting be approved. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

### REVIEW OF AGENCY RULEMAKINGS

*Capital Development Board – Illinois Energy Conservation Code (71 Ill. Adm. Code 600; 42 Ill. Reg. 21491)*

Rep. Halpin moved, seconded by Sen. Muñoz, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Capital Development Board, extend the Second Notice Period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

### AGENCY RESPONSES

*Department of Insurance – Required Procedure for Filing and Securing Approval of Policy Forms (50 Ill. Adm. Code 916; 42 Ill. Reg. 17342)*

Due to the appropriateness of the agency's response, no further action was taken.

***Department of Insurance – Premium Trust Fund Account (50 Ill. Adm. Code 3113; 42 Ill. Reg. 18372)***

Due to the appropriateness of the agency's response, no further action at this time. Staff will monitor.

***Department of Public Health – Skilled Nursing and Intermediate Care Facilities Code (77 Ill. Adm. Code 300; 42 Ill. Reg. 18553) and Sheltered Care Facilities Code (77 Ill. Adm. Code 330; 42 Ill. Reg. 18568)***

Due to the appropriateness of the agency's responses, no further action was taken.

**CONSIDERATION OF OTHER RULEMAKINGS**

***Illinois Commerce Commission – Regulatory Accounting Treatment for Cloud-Based Computing Solutions (83 Ill. Adm. Code 289; 42 Ill. Reg. 12369)***

Brian Allen represented ICC. He confirmed that ICC would concur in an Extension. Rep. Demmer moved, seconded by Sen. Weaver, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Illinois Commerce Commission, extend the Second Notice Period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

***Department of Healthcare and Family Services – Medical Payment (89 Ill. Adm. Code 140; 42 Ill. Reg. 14043)***

Kim Schultz, representing HFS, confirmed that the Department concurred in an Extension. Rep. Reick moved, seconded by Rep. Hurley, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, extend the Second Notice Period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

***Department of Public Health – Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias Service Code (77 Ill. Adm. Code 973; 42 Ill. Reg. 19510)***

Erin Conley represented DPH. She confirmed that the Department would concur in an Extension. Sen. Rezin moved, seconded by Rep. Halpin, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Department of Public Health, extend the Second Notice Period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

**CERTIFICATION OF NO OBJECTION**

Sen. Weaver moved, seconded by Rep. Thapedi, that the Committee inform the agencies to whose rulemakings the Committee has not voted an Objection or Extension, or did not remove from the No Objection List, that the Committee considered their respective rulemakings at the monthly meeting and, based upon the agreements for modification of the rulemaking made by the agency, no Objections will be issued. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).
