

Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.

Proposed Rulemakings

■ IEMA GRANTS

The ILLINOIS EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY proposed a new Part titled General Grantmaking (IEMA) (44 IAC 7030; 43 Ill Reg 7903) implementing the Grant Accountability and Transparency Act (GATA). The Part provides that all State or federally funded grants that pass through IEMA to grant awardees are subject to federal grant reporting, invoicing and audit requirements in 2 CFR 200, except for certain grants (e.g., federal disaster assistance, Homeland Security grants) that are subject to separate federal or State laws and have been specifically exempted by the

Grant Accountability and Transparency Unit (GATU) within the Governor's Office of Management and Budget. Small municipalities, other units of local government, and non-profit agencies that receive IEMA grants may be affected by this rulemaking.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

The ILLINOIS COMMERCE COMMISSION proposed repeal of the Part titled Competition

Reporting (83 IAC 793; 43 Ill Reg 7891) which currently requires local exchange service telecommunications carriers and Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) providers to make annual reports to ICC and requires ICC to compile this information for use in an annual report on State telecommunications markets. The statute that this Part implements (Section 13-407 of the Public Utilities Act) was repealed effective 8/13/18.

PROPOSED RULES: Rules proposed by agencies this week, commencing a 45-day First Notice period during which public comments must be accepted.
PEREMPTORY RULES: Rules adopted without prior public notice or JCAR review as authorized by 5 ILCS 100/5-50.
■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.
