

Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.

Proposed Rulemakings

JUVENILE JUSTICE

The DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE proposed amendments to the Part titled Research and Evaluation (20 IAC 2206; 44 Ill Reg 3304) that update required information to be submitted in any formal research or evaluation proposal (for studies of former or present committed youth, employees, programs or facilities). Research proposals must now include steps that will be taken to ensure participant confidentiality and anonymity in the process of data collection and reporting. Proposals must also include a data sharing agreement, and all requests for research or evaluation must be approved by the DJJ Director and the Deputy Director of the appropriate division. DJJ also proposed repeal of the Part titled Reimbursement for Expenses (20 IAC 2210; 44 Ill Reg 3309)

to reflect Public Act 101-235. This PA repealed a statute that formerly authorized DJJ (and its predecessor, the adult Department of Corrections) to seek repayment from offenders for the costs of their incarceration.

HORSE RACING

The ILLINOIS RACING BOARD proposed amendments to Medication (11 IAC 603; 44 Ill Reg 3315) that update its incorporation of the Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances issued by the Association of Racing Commissioners International

ADOPTED RULES: Rules adopted by agencies this week. **EMERGENCY RULES:** Adopted for a temporary period not to exceed 150 days.
PROPOSED RULES: Rules proposed by agencies this week, commencing a 45-day First Notice period during which public comments must be accepted.
PEREMPTORY RULES: Rules adopted without prior public notice or JCAR review as authorized by 5 ILCS 100/5-50.
■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.
