
Dear President Cullerton:

I am in receipt of your letter of May 22, 2012, concerning the above matter. I am in agreement with the corrective and disciplinary action taken by your office. As a result, pursuant to the provisions of Section 25-50(c-5) of the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act (5 ILCS 430/25-50(c-5)), I have elected not to file a complaint with the Legislative Ethics Commission with respect to Ms. Dowis.

Be advised that pursuant Section 25-50(c-10), the Commission may request further investigation by this office, and may also refer the summary report and your response to the Attorney General for further investigation or review. Be also advised that pursuant to Section 25-52, in cases that result in at least 3 days suspension, within 60 days after receipt of the summary report and response, the Commission is required to make the report and response or a redacted version thereof available to the public. In addition, the Commission may make available to the public any other summary report and response.
