Senate Bills--Second Reading

A-S.B. 2458 -- (Madigan) Kotowski - Steans - Trotter --- AN ACT concerning appropriations. (CA 1) Short Debate

S.B. 2480 -- (Madigan) Steans --- AN ACT concerning appropriations. (CA 1) Short Debate

Order of Resolutions

H.J.R. 34 -- Yarbrough --- Supports the United States Environmental Protection Agency in its efforts to protect the health of Illinoisans and fulfill the charge of the Clean Air Act to clean up dangerous air pollution, including mercury, lead, soot, smog, and carbon pollution. (Environmental Health RBA)

H.J.R. 35 -- D'Amico - Smith --- Creates the Secretary of State's Advisory Committee on Traffic Safety to look at all aspects of traffic safety in an effort to determine legislative and administrative action that can be taken to lower the number of traffic-related fatalities in Illinois. (Transportation: Vehicles & Safety RBA)

H.J.R. 36 -- Zalewski --- Resolves that there is created the Assistive Technology Evaluation and Training Centers Task Force to (i) study the effectiveness of the Assistive Technology Evaluation and Training Centers Act in protecting consumers from manufacturing defects and warranty abuses by assistive technology manufacturers and (ii) submit a report to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2011 on the results of the study with recommendations for any necessary legislative changes to the Act. (Human Services RBA)

H.R. 371 -- Bellock --- Designates November 4, 2011 as Heroin Abuse Awareness Day in the State of Illinois. (Human Services RBA)

H.R. 373 -- Mitchell, Bill - Cavaletto --- Designates the date of May 23, 2011 as "Mt. Pulaski High School Teens Drive Safe Day" in the State of Illinois. (Elementary & Secondary Education RBA)

H.R. 382 -- Davis, William --- Encourages the State Health Improvement Plan Implementation Council to prepare a report to the General Assembly on the State's public health policies and policymaking infrastructure that shall include an Illinois policy agenda. (Human Services RBA)

H.R. 383 -- Gabel --- Urges the Governor and the Illinois Secretary of State to convene a task force or working group to explore, discuss, and coordinate efforts to conduct a public awareness campaign to educate the general public about the value of cycling to children, along with the safety benefits of children wearing bicycle helmets. (Human Services RBA)

H.R. 390 -- Zalewski --- Urges Congress and the U.S. Department of Transportation to pass legislation that curtails the use of police-checkpoint smartphone applications in the United States. (Transportation: Vehicles & Safety RBA)

H.R. 395 -- Bradley --- Designates the portion of State Highway 13 between Route 166 and the Saline County line as the "Lory L. Price Memorial Highway". (Transportation Regulation, Roads and Bridges RBA)

Order of Resolutions

H.R. 411 -- Pritchard --- Urges parents and caregivers to check the ESRB ratings when selecting computer and video games for children. Encourages interactive entertainment software creators to submit their video, computer, and online games to be rated by the ESRB. Urges all interactive entertainment software creators, including video and computer game creators, to refrain from creating games based on real-life tragedies and violence against children. (Elementary & Secondary Education RBA)
