the accused; and (6) have the safety of the victim and
the victim's family considered in denying or fixing
the amount of bail, determining whether to release
the defendant, and setting conditions of release after
arrest and conviction. Provides that nothing in this
Constitutional provision creates any cause of action
for compensation or damages against the State, any
political subdivision of the State, any officer,
employee, or agent of the State or of any of its
political subdivisions, or any officer or employee of
the court. Effective upon being declared adopted.
