- H.J.R. 1 -- Thapedi --- Extends the operation of the Cybersecurity Task Force originally created by House Joint Resolution 59 of the 100th General Assembly. (CA 1-T) (FA 2-RBA) (Cybersecurity, Data Analytics, & IT RBA)
- H.J.R. 16 -- Murphy --- Creates the State Sponsored Health Clinic Task Force to study the possibility of implementing a State of Illinois sponsored health clinic for state employees, dependents, and retirees, with the purpose of providing quality care and annual savings to State's overall group insurance costs. (State Government Administration RBA)

Order of Resolutions

H.J.R. 24 -- Mah - Feigenholtz - Sommer - Ramirez - Gong-Gershowitz --- Supports, as a civil right, automatic citizenship to all qualifying children adopted by a U.S. citizen parent, regardless of the date on which the adoption was finalized. Condemns the deportation of individuals who were adopted into American homes and should have every expectation that their citizenship matches that of their adoptive parents. Welcomes legislation that will provide citizenship for all adult adoptees whose adoptive parents did not complete the naturalization process while they were children. (Adoption & Child Welfare RBA)

H.R. 20 -- Bennett --- Urges restitution be paid to the victim before any court or law imposed cost, fine, fee, assessment, or other payment by the defendant is paid. (Judiciary - Criminal RBA)

H.R. 34 -- Davis - Mayfield --- Recognizes the 40th anniversary of the United States Congress's enacting of the Taiwan Relations Act and reiterates support for a closer economic and trade partnership between the United States and Taiwan. (International Trade & Commerce RBA)
