Messages from the Senate

- S.J.R. 51 -- Biss --- Designates February 19, 2014 as a Day of Remembrance in the State of Illinois in order to increase public awareness of the forced removal and incarceration of Japanese-Americans during World War II.
- S.J.R. 54 -- Sullivan --- Supports the United States Department of Transportation's designation of the M-35 from St. Louis, Missouri to St. Paul, Minnesota and the M-55 from Chicago via St. Louis, Missouri to New Orleans, Louisiana as Marine Highway Corridors. Encourages support for the local drainage sponsors and the United States Army Corps of Engineers' Upper Mississippi River Comprehensive Plan, as approved by the Mississippi River Commission, for systemic flood control planning and implementation. Supports the streamlining of the State Levee Permitting process to encourage and facilitate both flood control and navigation improvements to Illinois levee systems.
- S.J.R. 61 -- Althoff --- Recognizes brothers G. Earle Eldredge and Charles Marcus Eldredge on their service and sacrifice as conservation officers and requests signage be erected within the nature preserve at Nippersink Creek acknowledging their sacrifices.
