W. Murphy: "The House will be in order. We will have the prayer by Joseph Cary of Centerville."

Cary: "Let us pray. Out of the depths, I've cried to Thee O Lord. O Lord hear my voice. My voice today is that every Member will be blessed throughout the coming year. Amen."

W. Murphy: "Messages.. from the Senate? Ah.. Messages from the Clerk."

F. B. Selcke: "Ah.. to the Honorable W. Robert Blair, Speaker of the House of Representatives and Members of the House of Representatives, 77th General Assembly, Gentlemen, I'm enclosing herewith correct copy of a proclamation of his Excellency, Richard B. Ogilvie, filed in my office the 28th Day of December, 1972, given under my hand the great seal of the state on this second day of January, 1973, John W. Lewis, Secretary of State.. Proclamation.. Whereas I deemed that an extraordinary occasion exists for convening the 77th General Assembly in a Special Session, now I therefore, Richard B. Ogilvie, Governor of the State of Illinois, by the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State of Illinois do hereby call and convene a Special Session of the 77th General Assembly in the State of Illinois to commence on the second day of January, A. D. 1973 at 4:00 p.m., Central Standard Time for the following purposes: (1) To enact laws and amend a repeal of existing laws or parts there to authorize



salaries for the elected officers of the Executive Branch. (2) To enact laws and amend or repeal existing laws or parts thereof to authorize salaries for officers of the Judiciary. (3) To enact laws and to amend or repeal existing laws or parts thereof to authorize allowances and expenses for the Members of the General Assembly and (4) to make appropriations for such purposes. Witness whereof I've hereto set my hand and cause the great seal of the State of Illinois to be affixed at the capitol and the City of Springfield, this 27th Day of December in the year of our Lord 1972 and of the State of Illinois 155th, Richard B. Ogilvie, Governor."

W. Murphy: "Gentleman from Cook, Mr. O'Hallaren wish to introduce a bill?"

O'Hallaren: "No, Mr. Speaker."

W. Murphy: "I thought maybe you had a salary bill there, Bernie. Any other business before the House."

Hyde: "Mr. Speaker, I now move that the House stand in recess until the hour of 9:30 on Wednesday morning.. or ah.. adjourned.. adjourned."

W. Murphy: "The House adjourn until Wednesday at 9:30 on January the 3rd. All in favor signify by saying 'aye'."

Members: "Aye".

W. Murphy: "Opposed, no. The 'ayes' have it and the House stand adjourned."
