A law reducing the number of Appellate or Circuit Judges or Associate Judges outside Cook County shall be without prejudice to the right of the Judges affected to seek retention in office. A reduction shall become effective when a vacancy occurs in the affected unit. For the purposes of this Section, the 'judge' includes Associate Judge outside Cook County. This Amendment shall take effect upon its adoption by the electors of this State and shall apply to vacancies occurring in the office of Associate Judge outside Cook County on or after its adoption.
