Amends the Elections Code. Provides that records must be kept for all contributions in excess of \$50. Repeals the recordkeeping exemption for purchases of licensed raffle tickets valued under \$150.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section 9-7 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/9-7) (from Ch. 46, par. 9-7)
- 7 Sec. 9-7. Records and accounts.
- 8 (1) The Except as provided in subsection (2), the treasurer
 9 of a political committee shall keep a detailed and exact
 10 account of-
- 11 (a) the total of all contributions made to or for the committee;
- (b) the full name and mailing address of every person making a contribution <u>in excess of \$50</u> and the date and amount thereof:
- 16 (c) the total of all expenditures made by or on behalf 17 of the committee;
 - (d) the full name and mailing address of every person to whom any expenditure is made, and the date and amount thereof; and
- 21 (e) proof of payment, stating the particulars, for 22 every expenditure made by or on behalf of the committee.
- The treasurer shall preserve all records and accounts

1 required by this <u>Section</u> section for a period of 2 years.

- (2) The treasurer of a political committee shall keep a detailed and exact account of the total amount of contributions made to or for a committee at an event licensed under Section 8.1 of the Raffles and Poker Runs Act. For an event licensed under Section 8.1, the treasurer is not required to keep a detailed and exact account of the full name and mailing address of a person who purchases tickets at the event in an amount that does not exceed \$150.
