1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 469

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 469 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Section 3-808.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-808.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-808.1)

7 Sec. 3-808.1. (a) Permanent vehicle registration plates
8 shall be issued, at no charge, to the following:

9 1. Vehicles, other than medical transport vehicles,
10 owned and operated by the State of Illinois or by any State
11 agency financed by funds appropriated by the General
12 Assembly;

13 2. Special disability plates issued to vehicles owned
14 and operated by the State of Illinois or by any State
15 agency financed by funds appropriated by the General
16 Assembly.

1 (b) Permanent vehicle registration plates shall be issued,
2 for a one time fee of \$8.00, to the following:

3 1. Vehicles, other than medical transport vehicles,
4 operated by or for any county, township or municipal
5 corporation.

6 2. Vehicles owned by counties, townships or municipal
7 corporations for persons with disabilities.

8 3. Beginning with the 1991 registration year,
9 county-owned vehicles operated by or for any county sheriff
10 and designated deputy sheriffs. These registration plates
11 shall contain the specific county code and unit number.

12 4. All-terrain vehicles owned by counties, townships,
13 or municipal corporations and used for law enforcement
14 purposes when the Manufacturer's Statement of Origin is
15 accompanied with a letter from the original manufacturer or
16 a manufacturer's franchised dealer stating that this
17 all-terrain vehicle has been converted to a street worthy
18 vehicle that meets the equipment requirements set forth in
19 Chapter 12 of this Code.

20 5. Beginning with the 2001 registration year,
21 municipally-owned vehicles operated by or for any police
22 department. These registration plates shall contain the
23 designation "municipal police" and shall be numbered and
24 distributed as prescribed by the Secretary of State.

25 6. Beginning with the 2014 registration year,
26 municipally owned, fire district owned, or Mutual Aid Box

1 Alarm System (MABAS) owned vehicles operated by or for any
2 fire department, fire protection district, or MABAS. These
3 registration plates shall display the designation "Fire
4 Department" and shall display the specific fire
5 department, fire district, fire unit, or MABAS division
6 number or letter.

7 7. Beginning with the 2017 registration year, vehicles
8 that do not require a school bus driver permit under
9 Section 6-104 to operate, and are owned by a public school
10 district from grades K-12 or a public community college.

11 8. Beginning with the 2017 registration year, vehicles
12 of the first division or vehicles of the second division
13 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds that are owned by a
14 medical facility or hospital of a municipality, county, or
15 township.

16 (b-5) Beginning with the 2016 registration year, permanent
17 vehicle registration plates shall be issued for a one-time fee
18 of \$8.00 to a county, township, or municipal corporation that
19 owns or operates vehicles used for the purpose of community
20 workplace commuting as defined by the Secretary of State by
21 administrative rule. The design and color of the plates shall
22 be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary
23 of State may adopt rules to implement this subsection (b-5).

24 (c) Beginning with the 2012 registration year,
25 county-owned vehicles operated by or for any county sheriff and
26 designated deputy sheriffs that have been issued registration

1 plates under subsection (b) of this Section shall be exempt
2 from any fee for the transfer of registration from one vehicle
3 to another vehicle. Each county sheriff shall report to the
4 Secretary of State any transfer of registration plates from one
5 vehicle to another vehicle operated by or for any county
6 sheriff and designated deputy sheriffs. The Secretary of State
7 shall adopt rules to implement this subsection (c).

8 (c-5) Beginning with the 2014 registration year,
9 municipally owned, fire district owned, or Mutual Aid Box Alarm
10 System (MABAS) owned vehicles operated by or for any fire
11 department, fire protection district, or MABAS that have been
12 issued registration plates under subsection (b) of this Section
13 shall be exempt from any fee for the transfer of registration
14 from one vehicle to another vehicle. Each fire department, fire
15 protection district, of MABAS shall report to the Secretary of
16 State any transfer of registration plates from one vehicle to
17 another vehicle operated by or for any fire department, fire
18 protection district, or MABAS. The Secretary of State shall
19 adopt rules to implement this subsection.

20 (d) Beginning with the 2013 registration year,
21 municipally-owned vehicles operated by or for any police
22 department that have been issued registration plates under
23 subsection (b) of this Section shall be exempt from any fee for
24 the transfer of registration from one vehicle to another
25 vehicle. Each municipal police department shall report to the
26 Secretary of State any transfer of registration plates from one

1 vehicle to another vehicle operated by or for any municipal
2 police department. The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to
3 implement this subsection (d).

4 (e) Beginning with the 2016 registration year, any vehicle
5 owned or operated by a county, township, or municipal
6 corporation that has been issued registration plates under this
7 Section is exempt from any fee for the transfer of registration
8 from one vehicle to another vehicle. Each county, township, or
9 municipal corporation shall report to the Secretary of State
10 any transfer of registration plates from one vehicle to another
11 vehicle operated by or for any county, township, or municipal
12 corporation.

13 (f) Except as provided in paragraph 7 of subsection (b) of
14 this Section, beginning with the 2019 registration year,
15 vehicles owned or operated by or for a private or public
16 university police department or a private or public college
17 police department, except for motor driven cycles and
18 all-terrain vehicles, may be registered under subsection (b) of
19 this Section. These registration plates shall contain the
20 designation "university police" or "college police" and shall
21 be numbered and distributed as prescribed by the Secretary of
22 State.
