1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 644
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 644 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5	Municipal Finance Transparency Act.
6	Section 5. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to establish
7	an alert system, directed by the State Comptroller, to annually
8	identify municipalities that are in or approaching financial
9	distress.
10	Section 10. Definitions. For the purpose of this Act,
11	unless context indicates otherwise:
12	"Municipality" means a city, village, or incorporated
13	town.
14	"Financial distress" means a financial state which may

include, but is not limited to, when a municipality is deemed

- to be in danger of being unable to fund basic services, make 1
- principle and interest payments on bonds or notes, make 2
- 3 statutorily required pension contributions, or make payroll,
- 4 according to criteria established by the State Comptroller in
- 5 consultation with the State Comptroller Local Government
- Advisory Board. 6
- "Financial indicators" means a municipality's reported 7
- 8 revenues, expenditures, debt, liabilities, assets, and pension
- liabilities across all funds and component units derived from 9
- 10 audits and financial reports submitted to the State Comptroller
- or other documents available to the State Comptroller. 11
- 12 Section 15. Index system.
- (a) The State Comptroller shall establish an index system 13
- 14 to identify municipalities that are in or approaching financial
- 15 distress.
- 16 (b) If any municipality has failed to submit annual audits
- 17 or financial reports to the State Comptroller as required by
- 18 law, then the Comptroller shall indicate in the annual index
- 19 that the municipality is not in compliance.
- 2.0 (c) The State Comptroller shall make public the criteria
- 21 used to determine whether a municipality is in or approaching
- 22 financial distress.
- 2.3 Section 20. Review of audits. The State Comptroller shall
- review audits and financial reports obtained under the 24

- 1 Governmental Account Audit Act or the Illinois Municipal
- 2 Auditing Law, in addition to any other reports or records the
- 3 State Comptroller deems relevant, and publish an annual report
- 4 identifying the fiscal health of municipalities.
- Section 25. Notice. The State Comptroller shall provide any municipality that will be identified as being in or approaching
- 7 financial distress advance written notice of such designation,
- 8 and shall also provide a method by which the municipality may
- 9 provide additional information that might influence such
- 10 designation. Nothing in this Section shall be construed as
- 11 preventing the State Comptroller from identifying a
- municipality as being in or approaching financial distress.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect one year
- 14 after becoming law.".
