# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by 5 changing Section 2.18 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 10/2.18) (from Ch. 23, par. 2212.18)

Sec. 2.18. "Day care homes" means family homes which receive more than 3 up to a maximum of 12 children for less than 24 hours per day. <u>The</u> The number counted includes the family's natural or adopted children and all other persons under the age of 12. The term does not include facilities which receive only children from a single household.
