2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 1618 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4 5	"Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by changing Section 6-133 as follows:
6	(605 ILCS 5/6-133)
7	Sec. 6-133. Abolishing a road district in Cook County. By
8	resolution, the board of trustees of any township located in
9	Cook County, Illinois, may submit a proposition to abolish the
10	road district of that township to the electors of that township
11	at a general election or consolidated election in accordance
12	with the general election law. The ballot shall be in
13	substantially the following form:

In the event that a majority of the electors voting on such proposition are in favor thereof, then the road district shall be abolished by operation of law effective on <u>the date the term</u> <u>of the highway commissioner in office at the time</u> January 1 of the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the proposition was approved by the electors <u>expires</u>.

On that date, all the rights, powers, duties, assets, 12 13 property, liabilities, obligations, and responsibilities of 14 the road district shall by operation of law vest in and be assumed by the township. On that date, the township board of 15 16 trustees shall assume all taxing authority of a road district abolished under this Section. On that date, any highway 17 18 commissioner of the abolished road district shall cease to hold office, such term having been terminated. Thereafter, the 19 20 township shall exercise all duties and responsibilities of the 21 highway commissioner as provided in the Illinois Highway Code. 22 The township board of trustees may enter into a contract with the county, a municipality, or a private contractor to 23 24 administer the roads under its jurisdiction. The township board of trustees shall assume all taxing authority of a township 25

1 road district abolished under this subsection. For purposes of

2 distribution of revenue, the township shall assume the powers,

3 duties, and obligations of the road district.
