This Act may be cited as the 4 5 Police Service Dog Protection Act. 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act: 7 "Law enforcement agency" means a county, municipal, or 8 State law enforcement agency. "Police dog" has the same meaning ascribed to the term in 9 subsection (e) of Section 3.55 of the Emergency Medical 10 Services (EMS) Systems Act. 11 12 Section 10. Medical care. (a) The law enforcement agency, or handler of the police dog shall be required to have 13 every police dog receive, at minimum, an annual medical 14

examination by a licensed veterinarian.

- 5 Section 15. Vehicles transporting police dogs; 6 requirements.
- 7 A vehicle used to transport a police dog shall be equipped 8 with a heat sensor monitoring device which shall:
  - (1) monitor the internal temperature of the vehicle in which the police dog is being transported;
  - (2) provide an audible and visual notification in the vehicle if the interior temperature reaches 85 degrees Fahrenheit which remotely notifies the law enforcement officer responsible for the police dog or the enforcement agency's 24 hour dispatch center; and
  - (3) have a safety mechanism to reduce the interior temperature of the vehicle.".
