1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1858

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1858 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Legislative Commission Reorganization Act  
5 of 1984 is amended by changing Section 8A-35 and by adding  
6 Section 8A-60 as follows:

7 (25 ILCS 130/8A-35)

8 Sec. 8A-35. Capitol Restoration Trust Fund;  
9 appropriations.

10 (a) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund is created as a  
11 special fund within the State treasury. The Fund may accept  
12 deposits from any source, whether private or public, and may be  
13 appropriated only for the use of the Architect of the Capitol  
14 in the performance of his or her powers and duties. The  
15 Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public funds for  
16 deposit into the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund.

1       (a-5) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a  
2 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the  
3 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a  
4 Presidential Statue at the State Capitol Building depicting  
5 President Ronald W. Reagan, as provided under Section 8A-60.  
6 The separate account may accept deposits from any source,  
7 whether private or public, and may be appropriated only for use  
8 by the Architect of the Capitol for expenses associated with  
9 the acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the  
10 Presidential Statue authorized under subsection (a) of Section  
11 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public  
12 funds for deposit into the separate account of the Capitol  
13 Restoration Trust Fund established under this subsection  
14 (a-5).

15       (a-10) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a  
16 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the  
17 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a  
18 Presidential Statue at the State Capitol Building depicting  
19 President Barack H. Obama, as provided under Section 8A-60. The  
20 separate account may accept deposits from any source, whether  
21 private or public, and may be appropriated only for use by the  
22 Architect of the Capitol for expenses associated with the  
23 acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the Presidential  
24 Statue authorized under subsection (b) of Section 8A-60. The  
25 Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public funds for  
26 deposit into the separate account of the Capitol Restoration

1 Trust Fund established under this subsection (a-10).

2 (a-15) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a  
3 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the  
4 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue  
5 at the State Capitol Building depicting Governor James R.  
6 Thompson, as provided under Section 8A-60. The separate account  
7 may accept deposits from any source, whether private or public,  
8 and may be appropriated only for use by the Architect of the  
9 Capitol for expenses associated with the acquisition,  
10 placement, and maintenance of the statue authorized under  
11 subsection (c) of Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol  
12 may seek private and public funds for deposit into the separate  
13 account of the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under  
14 this subsection (a-15).

15 (a-20) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a  
16 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the  
17 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue  
18 at the State Capitol Building depicting State Representative  
19 and Illinois labor union leader Reuben G. Soderstrom, as  
20 provided under Section 8A-60. The separate account may accept  
21 deposits from any source, whether private or public, and may be  
22 appropriated only for use by the Architect of the Capitol for  
23 expenses associated with the acquisition, placement, and  
24 maintenance of the statue authorized under subsection (d) of  
25 Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol may seek private  
26 and public funds for deposit into the separate account of the

1 Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under this  
2 subsection (a-20).

3 (b) The Architect of the Capitol shall submit all budget  
4 requests to implement the master plan that relate to areas of  
5 the legislative complex other than the State Capitol Building  
6 to the Capitol Historic Preservation Board for review and  
7 comment. The Architect of the Capitol shall submit all budget  
8 requests to the Board of the Office of the Architect of the  
9 Capitol for approval.

12 Sec. 8A-60. State Capitol statues.

13 (a) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
14 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall  
15 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the  
16 State Capitol Building depicting 40th President of the United  
17 States Ronald W. Reagan. The Architect of the Capitol may  
18 provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may  
19 otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a  
20 statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a  
21 suitable statue for placement under this Section.

22 (b) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
23 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall  
24 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the  
25 State Capitol Building depicting 44th President of the United

1 States Barack H. Obama. The Architect of the Capitol may  
2 provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may  
3 otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a  
4 statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a  
5 suitable statue for placement under this Section.

6 (c) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
7 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall  
8 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the  
9 State Capitol Building depicting 37th Governor of the State of  
10 Illinois James R. Thompson. The Architect of the Capitol may  
11 provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may  
12 otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a  
13 statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a  
14 suitable statue for placement under this Section.

15 (d) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
16 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall  
17 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the  
18 State Capitol Building depicting State Representative and  
19 Illinois labor union leader Reuben G. Soderstrom. The Architect  
20 of the Capitol may provide for the design and fabrication of  
21 the statue, or may otherwise acquire, using funds collected for  
22 such purpose or a statue donated to the Office of the Architect  
23 of the Capitol, a suitable statue for placement under this  
24 Section.

25 (e) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
26 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall take

1 actions necessary to provide for the placement and unveiling of  
2 the Presidential Statues authorized under subsections (a) and  
3 (b) at the Capitol by February 15, 2021 (Presidents' Day).  
4 Prior to the placement of the statues at the Capitol, the  
5 Architect of the Capitol shall issue a report detailing his or  
6 her actions in acquiring and placing the statues specified  
7 under this subsection (e). The report shall be delivered to the  
8 Governor and the General Assembly on or before December 1,  
9 2020. The report to the General Assembly shall be filed with  
10 the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of  
11 the Senate in electronic form only, in the manner that the  
12 Clerk and the Secretary shall direct.

13 (f) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the  
14 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall take  
15 actions necessary to provide for the placement and unveiling of  
16 the statues authorized under subsections (c) and (d) within a  
17 reasonable period of time after the effective date of this  
18 amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, except that,  
19 notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (e), the statue  
20 depicting Reuben G. Soderstrom shall be placed on Capitol  
21 grounds before any other statue authorized under this Section.  
22 Prior to the placement of the statues at the Capitol, the  
23 Architect of the Capitol shall issue a report detailing his or  
24 her actions in acquiring and placing the statues specified  
25 under this subsection (f). The report shall be delivered to the  
26 Governor and the General Assembly. The report to the General

1 Assembly shall be filed with the Clerk of the House of  
2 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate in electronic  
3 form only, in the manner that the Clerk and the Secretary shall  
4 direct.

5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
6 becoming law.".
