Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning uniformity of taxes.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 8-3-5 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/8-3-5) (from Ch. 24, par. 8-3-5)

7 Sec. 8-3-5. All taxes levied by a municipality, except  
8 special assessments for local improvements, shall be uniform  
9 upon all taxable property and ~~and~~ persons within the limits of  
10 the municipality, and no property shall be exempt therefrom  
11 other than such property as may be exempt from taxation under  
12 the constitution and general laws of the State.
