## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 690/1

from Ch. 38, par. 81-1

Amends the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning prohibitions.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 690/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 81-1)
- 7 Sec. 1. Use prohibited. No person shall ingest, breathe, inhale or drink any compound, liquid, or chemical containing 8 9 toluol, hexane, trichloroethylene, acetone, toluene, ethyl acetate, methyl ethyl ketone, trichloroethane, isopropanol, 10 ketone, methyl 11 methyl isobutyl cellosolve 12 cyclohexanone, the the alkaloids atropine, hyoscyamine, or scopolamine, or any other substance for the purpose of inducing 13 14 condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, paralysis or irrational behavior, or in any manner 15 16 changing, distorting or disturbing the auditory, visual or mental processes. For the purposes of this Act, any such 17 condition so induced shall be deemed to be an intoxicated 18 19 condition.
