- on page 2, line 17, after "(1)" by inserting the following:

- on page 3, by replacing lines 8 through 11 with the following:
- ""Brief resolved unexplained event" means an episode that
- 11 occurs to a well-appearing infant up to 12 months old who
- 12 <u>experiences an event that lasts less than a minute and then</u>
