SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/50

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that renewal of a concealed carry license shall be for 10 years after the completion of 3 hours of training, payment of a renewal fee, and the completion of an investigation.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by changing Section 50 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 66/50)
- 7 Sec. 50. License renewal. Applications for renewal of a 8 license shall be made to the Department. A license shall be 9 renewed for a period of 10 $\frac{5}{2}$ years upon receipt of a completed 10 renewal application, completion of 3 hours of training required under Section 75 of this Act, payment of the applicable renewal 11 fee, and completion of an investigation under Section 35 of 12 this Act. The renewal application shall contain the information 13 14 required in Section 30 of this Act, except that the applicant need not resubmit a full set of fingerprints. 15
