10	(a) As used in this Section:
11	"Pharmacist" has the meaning given to that term in the
12	Pharmacy Practice Act.
13	"Pharmacy" has the meaning given to that term in the
14	Pharmacy Practice Act.
15	"Pharmacy benefits manager" means an entity that

- administers or manages a pharmacy benefits plan or program. 1
- 2 "Pharmacy benefits manager affiliate" means a pharmacy or
- 3 pharmacist that directly or indirectly, through one or more
- 4 intermediaries, owns or controls, is owned or controlled by, or
- 5 is under common ownership or control with a pharmacy benefits
- 6 manager.
- (b) By January 1, 2022, no pharmacy benefits manager shall 7
- 8 operate a pharmacy benefits manager affiliate in the State.
- (c) A pharmacy benefits manager may not reimburse a 9
- 10 pharmacy or pharmacist in the State an amount less than the
- 11 amount that the pharmacy benefits manager reimburses a pharmacy
- 12 benefits manager affiliate for providing the same pharmacist
- services. A pharmacy benefits manager shall not reimburse a 13
- 14 pharmacy or pharmacist in the State an amount less than the
- 15 amount that the pharmacy benefits manager reimburses any other
- 16 network pharmacy.
- (d) A pharmacy benefits manager may not prohibit a pharmacy 17
- or pharmacist from providing a customer with a more affordable 18
- 19 alternative if a more affordable alternative is available.
- 20 (e) A pharmacy benefits manager may not prohibit a pharmacy
- or pharmacist from allowing a pharmacy or pharmacist to 2.1
- 22 disclose any contract information to a legislator or government
- 23 agency.
- 24 (f) The Department of Insurance may examine any contracts
- 25 or audit any books and records of a pharmacy benefits manager
- 26 about which it receives a complaint under this Section.

(g) A pharmacy benefits manager contracting with a manage	∍d
care organization to administer pharmacy benefits for the Stat	:e
Employee Group Health Insurance or any county, municipal, o	r
school health plan shall allow the Auditor General to audit, a	at
his or her discretion, contracts, books, and records for	or
impermissible conduct under this Section.".
