Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

- 5 Section 15. The amount of \$2,041,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 6 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers' 7 8 Compensation Commission for costs associated with 9 establishment, administration and operations of the Insurance 10 Compliance Division of the workers' compensation anti-fraud administered by Illinois 11 program Workers' Compensation 12 Commission.
- Section 20. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers'
 Compensation Commission for costs associated with the
 establishment of the Medical Fee Schedule and other provisions
 of the Workers' Compensation Act.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 20 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General 21 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 22 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
