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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
8 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice
9 Information Authority:

 15 and non-profit organizations.

16 Section 20. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as
 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 18 Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 19 Authority for awards and grants to state agencies.

20 Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 21 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal

1 Justice Information Authority for activities undertaken in
 2 support of federal assistance programs administered by units
 3 of state and local government and non-profit organizations:

6 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal

 11 activities undertaken in support of investigating issues in
 12 criminal justice and for undertaking other criminal justice
 13 information projects:

11 Information Authority for grants to enhance and develop Crime

12 Stoppers programs in Illinois.

13 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

14 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes

15 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal

16 Justice Information Authority for the training of law

17 enforcement personnel and services for families of homicide or

18 murder:

6 Section 50. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill and
8 Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
9 Authority for the purpose of collection, transportation, and
10 incineration of pharmaceuticals by local law enforcement
11 agencies.

12 Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
14 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and contingent
15 expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
16 Authority:

9 Section 60. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
11 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the
12 purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative expenses
13 and all related costs for the Safe From the Start Program.

14 Section 65. The amount of \$525,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
16 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the
17 Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council Program.

18 Section 70. The amount of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
21 administrative costs, awards and grants for Community-Based
22 Violence Prevention Programs.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
3 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
4 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
