

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 HB4096

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-16.11

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall require each Medicaid Managed Care Organization to list as preferred on the Medicaid Managed Care Organization's preferred drug list every pharmaceutical that is listed as preferred on the Department's preferred drug list. Provides that the Department shall not prohibit, or adopt any rules or policies that prohibit, a Medicaid Managed Care Organization from: (i) covering additional pharmaceuticals that are not listed on the Department's preferred drug list; or (ii) removing from the Medicaid Managed Care Organization's preferred drug list any prior approval requirements applicable under the Department's preferred drug list. Provides that the Department shall not require a Medicaid Managed Care Organization to utilize a single, statewide preferred drug list and shall not prohibit a plan from negotiating drug pricing concessions or rebates on any drug with pharmaceutical companies, unless otherwise required by federal law. Provides that no later than July 1, 2018, the Department shall develop a standardized format for all Medicaid Managed Care Organization preferred drug lists in cooperation with Medicaid Managed Care Organizations and stakeholders, including, but not limited to, community-based organizations, providers, and individuals or entities with expertise in drug formulary development. Requires each Medicaid Managed Care Organization to post its preferred drug list on its website without restricting access to enrolled members and to update the preferred drug list posted on its website within 2 business days of making any changes to the preferred drug list, including, but not limited to, any and all changes to requirements for prior approval. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Section 5-16.11 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-16.11)
- Sec. 5-16.11. Uniform standards applied to managed care entities.
- 9 (a) As used in this Section:
- "Preferred drug list" means a list of preferred and
 non-preferred pharmaceuticals.
- "Preferred pharmaceutical" means a pharmaceutical covered

 under the medical assistance program that is not subject to

 prior authorization or other utilization controls.
- "Non-preferred pharmaceutical" means a pharmaceutical
 covered under the medical assistance program that is subject to
 prior authorization or other utilization controls.
- 18 <u>(b)</u> Any managed care entity providing services under this
 19 Code shall use a pharmacy formulary that is no more restrictive
 20 than the Illinois Department's pharmaceutical program.
- 21 <u>(c) The Illinois Department shall require each Medicaid</u>
 22 <u>Managed Care Organization to list as preferred on the Medicaid</u>
 23 Managed Care Organization's preferred drug list every

pharmaceutical that is listed as preferred on the Illinois

Department's preferred drug list. The Illinois Department
shall not prohibit, or adopt any rules or policies that
prohibit, a Medicaid Managed Care Organization from: (i)
covering additional pharmaceuticals that are not listed on the
Illinois Department's preferred drug list; or (ii) removing
from the Medicaid Managed Care Organization's preferred drug
list any prior approval requirements applicable under the
Illinois Department's preferred drug list.

The Illinois Department shall not require a Medicaid Managed Care Organization to utilize a single, statewide preferred drug list and shall not prohibit a plan from negotiating drug pricing concessions or rebates on any drug with pharmaceutical companies, unless otherwise required by federal law.

No later than July 1, 2018, the Illinois Department shall develop a standardized format for all Medicaid Managed Care Organization preferred drug lists in cooperation with Medicaid Managed Care Organizations and stakeholders, including, but not limited to, community-based organizations, providers, and individuals or entities with expertise in drug formulary development. Each Medicaid Managed Care Organization must post its preferred drug list on its website without restricting access to enrolled members and must update the preferred drug list posted on its website within 2 business days of making any changes to the preferred drug list, including, but not limited
