## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 5120/10

Amends the Flue Gas Desulfurization (FGD) Task Force Act. Extends the date by which the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly from December 31, 2017 to December 31, 2018. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Flue Gas Desulfurization (FGD) Task Force
Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 5120/10)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2019)

8 Sec. 10. The FGD Task Force.

9 (a) The FGD Task Force is hereby created to increase the amount of Illinois Basin coal use in generation units. The FGD 10 11 Task Force shall identify and evaluate the costs, benefits, and barriers of new and modified FGD, or other post-combustion 12 13 sulfur dioxide emission control technologies, and other 14 capital improvements, that would be necessary for generation units to comply with the sulfur dioxide National Ambient Air 15 16 Quality Standards (NAAQS) while improving the ability of those 17 generation units to meet the effluent limitation guidelines wastewater 18 (ELGs) for discharges and enhancing the 19 marketability of the generation units' FGD byproducts.

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(b) The membership of the Task Force shall be as follows:

(1) Two members of the Senate appointed by the
 President of the Senate.

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(2) Two members of the Senate appointed by the Minority

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1 Leader of the Senate.

2 (3) Two members of the House of appointed by the
3 Speaker of the House of Representatives.

4 (4) Two members of the House of Representatives
5 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
6 Representatives.

7 (5) Three members appointed by the Governor, two with 8 expertise in Illinois coal, coal mining, emission 9 reduction, or energy production; and one representative of 10 an electricity generator that owns multiple coal-fueled 11 electric generation plants with FGD or similar 12 technologies.

13 (6) The Director of Natural Resources, or his or her14 designee.

15 (7) The Director of the Environmental Protection16 Agency, or his or her designee.

17 (c) Task Force members shall serve without compensation but 18 shall be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred in performing 19 their duties.

20 (d) The Task Force shall report their findings and
21 recommendations to the General Assembly by December 31, <u>2018</u>
22 <del>2017</del>.
