SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

745 ILCS 49/77 new

Amends the Good Samaritan Act. Provides that any not-for-profit organization in this State or any person working at the organization who in good faith provides temporary or emergency overnight shelter without fee to a person experiencing homelessness shall not be liable for civil damages as a result of acts or omissions, except for willful or wanton misconduct on the part of the person or organization in providing the temporary or emergency overnight shelter. Provides that the new provisions do not apply to an organization whose primary purpose is to provide shelter to the homeless.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by adding Section 77 as follows:
- 6 (745 ILCS 49/77 new)
- 7 Sec. 77. Temporary overnight shelters; exemption from civil liability. Any not-for-profit organization in this State 8 9 or any person working at the organization who in good faith provides temporary or emergency overnight shelter without fee 10 to a person experiencing homelessness shall not be liable for 11 12 civil damages as a result of acts or omissions, except for willful or wanton misconduct on the part of the person or 13 14 organization in providing the temporary or emergency overnight 15 shelter.
- This Section does not apply to an organization whose primary purpose is to provide shelter to the homeless.
