SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1705/5.2 new

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Administrative Act. Provides that notwithstanding any State licensing law to the contrary, the Department of Human Services shall adopt rules, which shall be implemented within 6 months after the effective date of the bill, that would allow a person who has completed a psychiatric training program certification from any branch of the United States Armed Forces with at least one year of experience in a mental health setting to be recognized as a mental health professional for purposes of programs authorized or funded by the Department under the standards of practice and under the direction of a licensed mental health professional as authorized by the Department. Defines "licensed mental health professional".

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by adding Section
5.2 as follows:

Sec. 5.2. Mental health professional; Armed Forces 8 9 training. Notwithstanding any State licensing law to the 10 contrary, the Department of Human Services shall adopt rules, which shall be implemented within 6 months after the effective 11 12 date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, that would allow a person who has completed a psychiatric training 13 14 program certification from any branch of the United States Armed Forces with at least one year of experience in a mental 15 16 health setting to be recognized as a mental health professional 17 for purposes of programs authorized or funded by the Department under the standards of practice and under the direction of a 18 19 licensed mental health professional as authorized by the Department. In this Section, "licensed mental health 20 21 professional" means a person who is licensed or registered to 22 provide mental health services by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation or a board of registration duly 23

- 1 <u>authorized to register or grant licenses to persons engaged in</u>
- 2 the practice of providing mental health services in this State
- 3 <u>or any other state.</u>
