SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/3.4b new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that persons licensed to possess a concealed firearm under the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and current or retired police officers authorized by law to possess a concealed firearm shall be exempt from provisions of the Code prohibiting possession of those firearms.

- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 3.4b as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 3.4b. Exemption. Persons licensed to possess a</u>
- 8 concealed firearm under the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and
- 9 current or retired police officers authorized by law to possess
- 10 a concealed firearm shall be exempt from provisions of this
- 11 Code prohibiting possession of those firearms. However,
- 12 nothing in this Section authorizes the use of those firearms
- 13 except as authorized in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act, this
- 14 <u>Code</u>, or other law.
