1 AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act is
amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 625/3) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 333)

Sec. 3. Each food service establishment shall be under the operational supervision of a certified food service sanitation manager in accordance with rules promulgated under this Act.

10 By July 1, 1990, the Director of the Department of Public Health in accordance with this Act, shall promulgate rules for 11 the education, examination, and certification of food service 12 13 establishment managers and instructors of the food service 14 sanitation manager certification education programs. Beginning January 1, 2018, any individual who has completed a minimum of 15 8 hours of Department-approved training for food service 16 17 sanitation manager certification, inclusive of the examination, and received a passing score on the examination 18 19 set by the certification exam provider accredited under 20 standards developed and adopted by the Conference for Food 21 Protection or its successor organization, shall be considered 22 to be a certified food service sanitation manager. Beginning January 1, 2018, any individual who has completed a minimum of 23

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8 hours of Department-approved training for food service 1 sanitation manager instructor certification, inclusive of the 2 3 examination, and received a passing score on the examination set by the certification exam provider accredited under 4 5 standards developed and adopted by the Conference for Food Protection or its successor organization, shall be considered 6 7 to be a certified food service sanitation manager instructor. A 8 food service sanitation manager certificate and a food service 9 sanitation manager instructor certificate issued by the exam 10 provider shall be valid for 5 years and shall not be 11 transferable from the individual to whom it was issued. A food 12 service sanitation manager certificate issued by the 13 Department under this Section before January 1, 2018 is valid 14 until the expiration date stated on the certificate.

sanitation 15 For purposes of food service manager 16 certification, the Department shall accept only training 17 approved by the Department and certification exams accredited under standards developed and adopted by the Conference for 18 Food Protection or its successor. 19
