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AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Conveyances Act is amended by changing
Section 30 as follows:

6 (765 ILCS 5/30) (from Ch. 30, par. 29)

7 Sec. 30. All deeds, mortgages and other instruments of writing which are authorized to be recorded, shall take effect 8 9 and be in force from and after the time of filing the same for record, and not before, as to all creditors and subsequent 10 purchasers, without notice; and all such deeds and title papers 11 shall be adjudged void as to all such creditors and subsequent 12 purchasers, without notice, until the same shall be filed for 13 14 record. This Section is a pure-notice recording statute.
