A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The amount of \$6,130,900, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector General for its
8 ordinary and contingent expenses.

9 Section 10. The amount of \$1,610,800, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public
11 Transportation Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector
12 General for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

13 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
14 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary,
15 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all
16 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
