AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 7 the Human Rights Commission for operational expenses of the 8 Commission.

9 Section 5. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 11 the Human Rights Commission for the Illinois Torture Inquiry 12 Relief Commission.

13 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 14 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 15 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 16 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
