SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 225/5

from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 116.305

Amends the Private Sewage Disposal Licensing Act. Allows veterans of the United States Armed Forces who have been discharged under honorable conditions to pay 50% of the licensing and examination fees determined by the Department of Public Health to be issued a private sewage system installation contractor license or a private sewage disposal system pumping contractor license. The applicant's veteran status can be verified using his or her DD-214 form.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Private Sewage Disposal Licensing Act is
5 amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 225/5) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 116.305)

7 Sec. 5. (a) The Director shall issue a private sewage
8 system installation contractor license or a private sewage
9 disposal system pumping contractor license to persons applying
10 for such license who successfully pass a written examination
11 prepared by the Department and who pay the required annual
12 license fee in an amount determined by the Department. Each
13 person who holds a currently valid plumbing license issued
14 under the Illinois Plumbing License Law shall not be required
15 to pay the annual license fee required by this Section, but
16 such licensed person shall comply with all other provisions of
17 this Act, including the requirement for examination for
18 licensure.

19 (b) A license issued under this Act shall expire on
20 December 31 of the year issued, except that an original license
21 issued after October 1 and before December 31 shall expire on
22 December 31 of the following year.

23 The Department shall reinstate a license which expires

1 while a licensee is in the active military service of the
2 United States upon application to the Department by the former
3 licensee within 2 years after termination of such military
4 service, payment of the annual license fee, and submission of
5 evidence of such military service. Such license shall be
6 reinstated without examination and without payment of the
7 reinstatement fee.

8 (c) A private sewage disposal system pumping contractor or
9 a private sewage system installation contractor whose license
10 has expired for a period of less than 3 years may apply to the
11 Department for reinstatement of his license. The Department
12 shall issue such renewed license provided the applicant pays to
13 the Department all lapsed license fees, plus a reinstatement
14 fee determined by the Department. A license which has expired
15 for more than 3 years may be restored only by reapplying to
16 take the examination and by successfully passing the written
17 examination.

18 (d) A veteran of the United States Armed Forces who has
19 been discharged under honorable conditions shall pay 50% of the
20 written examination and annual license fees determined by the
21 Department to be issued a private sewage system installation
22 contractor license or a private sewage disposal system pumping
23 contractor license. The applicant's veteran status can be
24 verified using his or her DD-214 form.
