2 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois exempts State taxation of 3 retirement income; and WHEREAS, Retirees living on a fixed income have limited 4 5 ability to rejoin the workforce, face high health care costs, 6 and have little ability to save money; and 7 WHEREAS, Retirees could not have anticipated in their 8 lifetime of planning that their retirement income would 9 suddenly be taxed by the State, forcing them to cut already strained household budgets; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Retirees do pay many other taxes, such as federal 12 income taxes, property taxes, and sales taxes; and 13 WHEREAS, The exclusion of taxing retirement income 14 encourages residents to remain living throughout their
