1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to congratulate Bill Moore on the occasion 4 of his 100th birthday on November 15, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Bill Moore grew up on a 200-acre farm in Kentucky, the second youngest of nine children; he started school at the age of four and enrolled in college at 15; he received his degree in accounting at the age of 20 and earned a commission with the United States Navy, rising to the rank of senior lieutenant in the British West Indies; after he was discharged following the war, he and wife, Freda, settled in Aurora, where he started an accounting firm; and

WHEREAS, Bill Moore joined the Kiwanis Club of Aurora in 1950; he is still an active member, driving himself to the Prisco Community Center every Tuesday for the weekly noon meetings; he has been volunteering for the Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast fundraiser ever since the first local breakfast was held in 1951; he has participated in the chapter's numerous service projects, which have included everything from handing out peanuts to building playgrounds; he served as treasurer for five years and on the board of directors; and

WHEREAS, Bill Moore was named Kiwanian of the Year in 1986;

- in 2012, the Kiwanis Club of Aurora renamed its scholarship for
- 2 Waubonsee Community College graduates to attend Aurora
- 3 University the "G. William "Bill" Moore Scholarship"; that same
- 4 year, he was named honorary president of the college; he and
- 5 two other World War II veterans served as a grand marshals in
- 6 Aurora's 2017 Memorial Day parade; and
- WHEREAS, At age of 100, Bill Moore is the oldest member of
- 8 the Kiwanis Club of Aurora; therefore, be it
