WHEREAS, Pat Schultz was motivated to serve the Carpentersville community and became a trustee in 2009; she was recently elected to her third term; and

WHEREAS, Pat Schultz was instrumental in bringing Stanford's Battery, a nonprofit organization dedicated to preserving the country's Civil War-era history, to the village two years in a row for reenactment events; she also partnered with the Faithwalk Harvest Center to relaunch the clergy commission after a several-year hiatus; she served on the village's Audit and Finance Commission and as chairman of the Carpentersville Improvement Committee; she always challenged proposals that would have raised fees or taxes; and
