## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to congratulate the Jacksonville High 4 School Winterguard on their accomplishments at regional and 5 state competitions; and

WHEREAS, The Jacksonville High School Winterguard competed 6 7 at five Illinois Drill Team Association (IDTA) regional 8 competitions in the categories of AA Tall Flag and AA Lyrical 9 Flag; their Tall Flag routine was undefeated, earned first 10 place at all five regional competitions, and then qualified for 11 State; their Lyrical Flag routine earned second place at one regional competition, first place at 12 four regional 13 competitions, and qualified for State multiple times; for the 14 first time in Jacksonville High School history, both routines 15 won the State Championship title at the State Finals; and

16 WHEREAS, The Lyrical Flag routine was performed to the 17 acoustic version of the song "Fight Song" by Rachel Platten and focused on the story and the message of strength; each team 18 19 member chose a cause to support and raise awareness for, 20 adoption, ALS, Alzheimer's Disease, including anxietv 21 disorder, asthma, autism, breast cancer, cerebral palsy, child 22 abuse, childhood cancer, childhood disabilities, deafness, 23 domestic violence, epilepsy, gun, violence, heart disease,
