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1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 8 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 8, AS AMENDED, with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 1, as 3 4 follows: on page 9, line 3, after "1-10,", by inserting "1-15.20,"; and 5 by replacing line 26 on page 13 through line 20 on page 14 with 6 7 the following: "Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for contracts 8 entered into on or after October 1, 2017 under an exemption provided in any paragraph item (12) of this subsection (b)_L 10 except paragraph (1), (2), or (5), each State agency shall be 11 published in the Procurement Bulletin within 14 calendar days 12 13 after contract execution. The chief procurement officer shall 14 prescribe the form and content of the notice. The Illinois 15 Finance Authority shall provide the chief procurement officer, on a monthly basis, in the form and content prescribed by the

chief procurement officer, a report of contracts that are related to the procurement of goods and services identified in item (12) of this subsection (b). At a minimum, this report shall post to the appropriate procurement bulletin include the name of the contractor, a description of the supply or service provided, the total amount of the contract, the term of the contract, and the exception to the Code utilized. A copy of each of these contracts shall be made available to the chief procurement officer immediately upon request. The chief procurement officer shall submit a report to the Governor and General Assembly no later than November 1 of each year that shall include, at a minimum, an annual summary of the monthly information reported to the chief procurement officer."; and

- on page 27, immediately below line 13, by inserting the following:
- 16 "(30 ILCS 500/1-15.20)

Sec. 1-15.20. Construction, and construction-related, and construction support services. "Construction" means building, altering, repairing, improving, or demolishing any public structure or building, or making improvements of any kind to public real property. Construction does not include the routine operation, routine repair, or routine maintenance of existing structures, buildings, or real property.

"Construction-related services" means those services

- 1 including construction design, layout, inspection, support,
- 2 location study, research, development, feasibility or
- planning, or other investigative study undertaken by a 3
- 4 construction agency concerning construction or potential
- 5 construction.
- 6 "Construction support" means all equipment, supplies, and
- services that are necessary to the operation of a construction 7
- agency's construction program. "Construction support" does not 8
- 9 include construction-related services.

- on page 114, by replacing line 22 with "Sections 1.1 and 4.05 11
- 12 as follows:"; and
- 13 by replacing line 21 on page 116 through line 16 on page 117
- 14 with the following:
- "(a-10) Each chief procurement officer appointed pursuant 15
- to Section 10-20 of the Illinois Procurement Code, with joint 16
- 17 agreement of the respective agency or institution, may
- 18 authorize the purchase or lease of supplies and services which
- have been procured through a competitive process by a federal 19
- 20 agency; a consortium of governmental, educational, medical,
- research, or similar entities; or a group purchasing 21
- 22 organization of which the chief procurement officer or State
- 23 agency is a member or affiliate, including, without limitation,
- any purchasing entity operating under the federal General 24

1 Services Administration, the Higher Education Cooperation Act, and the Midwestern Higher Education Compact Act. Each 2 applicable chief procurement officer may authorize purchases 3 4 and contracts which have been procured through other methods of 5 procurement if each chief procurement officer determines it is 6 in the best interests of the State, considering a 7 recommendation by their respective agencies or institutions. The chief procurement officer may establish detailed rules, 8 9 policies, and procedures for use of these cooperative 10 contracts. Notice of award shall be published by the chief procurement officer in the Illinois Procurement Bulletin at 11 12 least prior to use of the contract. Each chief procurement 13 officer shall submit to the General Assembly by November 1 of 14 each year a report of procurements made under this subsection 15 (a-10)."; and

16 on page 124, by deleting lines 11 through 19.
