## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 405/5-125

Amends the Juvenile Court Act of 1987. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning prosecution of a traffic, boating, or fish and game law or ordinance violation committed by a minor.

1 AN ACT concerning courts.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Juvenile Court Act of 1987 is amended by 5 changing Section 5-125 as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 405/5-125)

Sec. 5-125. Concurrent jurisdiction. Any minor alleged to have violated a traffic, boating, or fish <u>and</u> and game law, or a municipal or county ordinance, may be prosecuted for the violation and if found guilty punished under any statute or ordinance relating to the violation, without reference to the procedures set out in this Article, except that:

(1) any detention, must be in compliance with thisArticle; and

(2) the confidentiality of records provisions in Part 9 15 16 of this Article shall apply to any law enforcement and court records relating to prosecution of a minor under 18 17 years of age for a municipal or county ordinance violation 18 19 or a violation of subsection (a) of Section 4 of the Cannabis Control Act or subsection (c) of Section 3.5 of 20 21 the Drug Paraphernalia Control Act; except that these 22 confidentiality provisions shall not apply to or affect any proceeding to adjudicate the violation. 23

For the purpose of this Section, "traffic violation" shall include a violation of Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012 relating to the offense of reckless homicide, Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, or any similar county or municipal ordinance.
