SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 5/3-802

from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 3-802

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Provides that when requested, a jury trial must be commenced within 15 days of the request unless a subsequent continuance is requested by the respondent. Provides that in counties of less than 500,000 inhabitants, a jury trial must be commenced within 30 days of the request unless a subsequent continuance is requested by the respondent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 3-802 as

follows:

- 7 (405 ILCS 5/3-802) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 3-802)
- 8 Sec. 3-802. The respondent is entitled to a jury on the
- 9 question of whether he <u>or she</u> is subject to involuntary
- 10 admission on an inpatient or outpatient basis. When requested,
- 11 <u>a jury trial must be commenced within 15 days of the request</u>
- 12 <u>unless a subsequent continuance is requested by the respondent.</u>
- However, in counties of less than 500,000 inhabitants, a jury
- 14 <u>trial must be commenced within 30 days of the request unless a</u>
- 15 <u>subsequent continuance is requested by the respondent.</u> The jury
- shall consist of 6 persons to be chosen in the same manner as
- 17 are jurors in other civil proceedings. A respondent is not
- 18 entitled to a jury on the question of whether psychotropic
- 19 medication or electroconvulsive therapy may be administered
- 20 under Section 2-107.1.
