1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 923

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 923, on page 2, by  
3 replacing lines 4 through 10 with the following:

4 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b), on and  
5 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th  
6 General Assembly, it is unlawful for a person to hold an office  
7 in a unit of local government with a salary, a stipend, or  
8 benefits in a combined amount that exceeds \$10,000 and also  
9 hold the office of county board member, township supervisor,  
10 township trustee, township assessor, or township clerk  
11 simultaneously.

12 (b) A person who simultaneously holds offices on the  
13 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General  
14 Assembly may complete his or her terms of office  
15 notwithstanding the prohibition in subsection (a). ~~It is lawful~~  
16 ~~for any person to hold the office of county board member and~~  
17 ~~township supervisor, and in counties of less than 100,000~~  
18 ~~population the office of county board member and township~~

1 ~~trustee, simultaneously. It is lawful for any person to hold~~  
2 ~~the office of county board member and the office of township~~  
3 ~~assessor or town clerk, simultaneously, in counties of less~~  
4 ~~than 300,000 population."; and~~

5 on page 2, line 20, after the period, by inserting "All actions  
6 of persons holding office for which simultaneous tenure is  
7 prohibited by this Act but who are permitted to complete their  
8 current terms of office under Section 2 of this Act are hereby  
9 validated."; and

10 on page 2, line 21, by replacing "in in" with "in"; and

11 on page 2, line 23, after "Assembly", by inserting "or after  
12 the completion of the current terms of office for persons  
13 holding office for which simultaneous tenure is prohibited  
14 under Section 2 of this Act, as applicable,".
