SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 315/2d

Amends the Communicable Disease Prevention Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the authority of the Department of Public Health to pay for health insurance coverage on behalf of HIV-infected persons.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Communicable Disease Prevention Act is amended by changing Section 2d as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 315/2d)
- 7 Sec. 2d. The The Illinois Department of Public Health may 8 pay for health insurance coverage with funds appropriated for 9 this purpose on behalf of persons who are infected with the 10 human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and are eligible for coverage" 11 "continuation as provided by the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 or group 12 health insurance policies. The Illinois Department of Public 13 14 Health shall adopt rules to establish income eligibility requirements for participation in this health insurance 15 coverage program. The Illinois Department of Public Health 16 shall also adopt rules and regulations to administer this 17 program that are in compliance with the requirements of the 18 19 federal Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency Act 20 of 1990.
