Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Power Agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The amount of \$3,201,400, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power  
7 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Operations Fund for its  
8 ordinary and contingent expenses.

9 Section 10. The amount of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power  
11 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Renewable Energy  
12 Resources Fund for funding of current and prior fiscal year  
13 purchases of renewable energy resources and related expenses,  
14 including the refund of bidder deposit fees overpayments of  
15 alternative compliance payments, and expenses related to the  
16 development and administration of the Illinois Solar for All  
17 Program, pursuant to subsections (b), (c), and (i) of Section  
18 1-56 of the Illinois Power Agency Act.

19 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July  
20 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General

1 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
2 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
