1 Section 5. The amount of \$5,808,100, or so much thereof 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 3 Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector General to meet 4 its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 5 2018.

6 Section 10. The amount of \$1,610,800, or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public 8 Transportation Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector 9 General to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year 10 ending June 30, 2018.

11 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 12 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General 13 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 14 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
